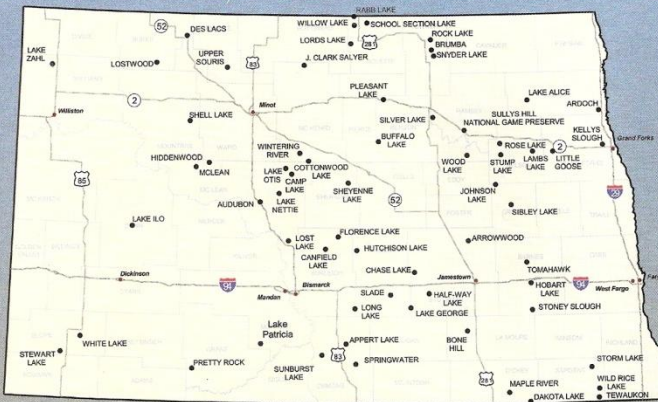

Here's a summary of North Dakota's major wildlife refuges:

Arrowwood NWR
Location: On US 52, go north to Edmunds and continue another .5 mile north, go east on Stutsman County Road 44 about five miles.
Size: 15,934 acres
Year established: Sept. 4, 1935

Audubon NWR
Location: On US 83, go two miles north of Coleharbor, then east .75 mile
Size: 14,738 acres
Year established: 1956

Chase Lake NWR
Location: 10 miles northwest of Medina (look for the sign on Stutsman County Road 68); headquarters is 3 miles east of Woodworth
Size: 4,385 acres.
Year established: 1908 (second oldest refuge in state)

Des Lacs NWR
Location: .5 mile west of Kenmare, off Ward County Road 1
Size: 19,500 acres, stretching from Canada-US border to 6 miles south of Kenmare

Lake Alice NWR
Location: 6.5 miles north of Penn; headquarters is in Devils Lake
Size: 12,179 acres
Year established: 1935

Lake Ilo NWR
Location: 5.5 miles east of the junction of North Dakota 200 and North Dakota 22 near Killdeer; then turn south to the headquarters.
Size: 3,197 acres

Long Lake NWR
Location: 1 mile south, 2.5 miles east and one mile northeast of Moffit
Size: 22,310 acres
Year established: 1932

Lostwood NWR
Location: 12 miles west of Kenmare on Ward County Road 2, and 4 miles south on ND 8. Or 21 miles north of Stanley on ND 8.
Size: 26,903 acres
Year established: 1935

Sullys Hill National Game Preserve
Location: 13 miles south of Devils Lake on ND 57, then south on BIA Road 6
